Other Suggested activities for Strike Day – Day One

EYFS/ KS1

- Read/share a book – either your book from school or from home.
- Talk about the story and what happened.
- Write a sentence about what happened.
- Draw a picture of your favourite character.
- Go on a Spring walk and talk about what you see around you and the weather. Draw a picture of what you saw on your walk and label the picture.
- Design a picnic or snack for your walk. Can you make this to take with you?
- Play a board game with your family. Is there one that involves counting like Snakes and Ladders or Ludo?
- Practise adding skills by rolling two dice and adding the total. What can you use to help you add? Eg Buttons, pasta, lego.

KS2

- Read a book and write a review of what you have read – be as creative as you can with how you present this information!
- Practice your times tables – don't forget to time yourselves
- Write your own mathematical problem (and don't forget to try it and work out the answer for yourselves)
- Design your own game for PE – what are the rules? How will it be played? How will you win?

Activity for Day 2

As this week is British Science week, we are setting all pupils the challenge to research a British Scientist that has changed the world!

Once you have researched and chosen your Scientist, it is then up to you how you present this information.

It could be in the form of:

- A poster
- A leaflet
- A power point presentation
